

Box

An AR of 4 to 5 is best for this weave. An AR of 5 will give a square cross-section. Box starts off the same as the Byzantine weave.

1. Starting with 4 closed rings and 2 open rings, make a 2-2-2 chain by putting one of the open rings through the four closed rings and closing it, then add and close the second open ring parallel to the first one.



2. Arrange as above and add a marker to one pair of end rings. The marker shows the beginning of the chain. You will be adding rings to the opposite end.



3. Fold back the pair of end rings, one either side.



4. Add a ring to the two folded back rings between the middle two rings.



5. Add another ring in the same place, parallel to the first.



6. Add two new rings through the last two rings.



7. Flip back the new rings as in step 3.



8. Add the next two rings and continue from step 6.
