

Half Persian 4 in 1

AR 4.6 and upwards. From 5.0 upwards is easier. This chain is very difficult to start and it may be worth keeping a spare piece of chain to start from rather than starting from scratch. Rings are shown in two colours for clarity. In the early stages of the weave, it is possible to pin the rings to a cushion (or similar) to stop them getting tangled and confused.



1. Connect three silver rings with one gold ring and lay out as shown above.



2. Add a new (gold) ring up through the eye (TE) made by the leftmost two silver rings and down through the right hand ring, add a silver ring to the gold ring before closing it. This step can be very tricky and you may find it easier to add the gold ring on its own first and then add the silver ring to it.



3. Now you simply need to repeat step 2 until the chain is the required length.
