

Roundmaille

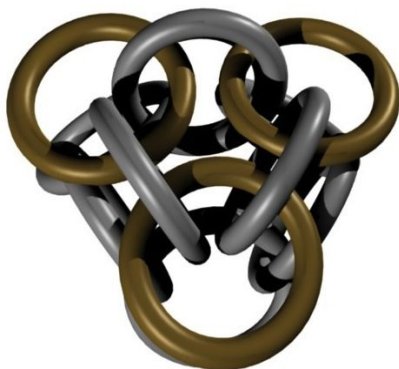
Roundmaille is basically a strip of European 4 in 1 “zipped up” to form a circular weave. Any AR that works for European 4 in 1 will also work for roundmaille.



1. Start with a 2-1-2-1-2 chain.



2. Close up the ends of the chain by adding a new (gold) ring through the two end pairs of silver rings.



3. Taking the inside (top) one of one set of paired rings plus the equivalent one of an adjacent pair, link these together with a new ring. Repeat with each pair of adjacent rings.



4. In the same way, link together the three rings just added with three new rings, remembering that the new rings should be added to the inside, not the outside.



5. Repeat with another three rings and continue until the required length is reached.
