

Turkish roundmaille

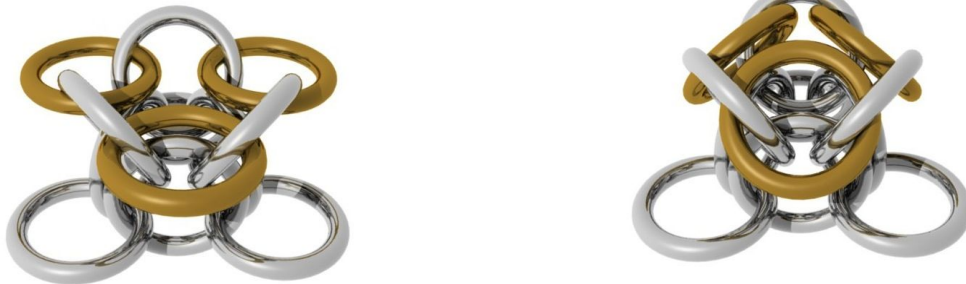
Use an AR of about 3.5 as for the related Byzantine weave.



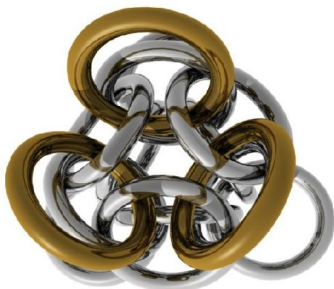
1. Make a 2-1-2-1-2 chain and then join the ends up with another single ring.



2. Flip up one of each pair of doubled rings.



3. Join each pair of flipped-up rings with a new ring (shown in gold). That's 3 new rings in total. Note that the new rings were added to the part of the flipped-up rings that is *outside* the chain. For the next step you will be adding to the *inside* of the chain, so you need to pull the new gold rings up in the middle of the chain as shown in the picture above right.



4. Add a new set of rings (shown in gold), but this time add them to the *inside* of the chain as shown.



5. Add a new set of rings (shown in gold) to the *outside* of the chain. The picture on the right above shows this stage of the chain from a different viewpoint.



Repeat steps 3, 4 and 5 for the length of chain required.
